



PGA of Canada Hall of Fame Nomination Form

The PGA of Canada Hall of Fame is dedicated to recognizing the extraordinary contribution and accomplishments of our Members to the game of golf in Canada and around the world. Deserving members will be inducted on a regular basis.

A Committee of Past Presidents, Honourary Directors, Members and representatives of the golf industry is responsible for reviewing nominations and selecting individuals for induction into the PGA of Canada Hall of Fame.

Once elected to the PGA of Canada Hall of Fame, the nominee is officially inducted at a special ceremony. Virtually housed, the Honoured Member's portrait and biography is then enshrined in the PGA of Canada Hall of Fame.

To be considered for election to the PGA of Canada Hall of Fame, the nominee must be/been a PGA of Canada member, be of the minimum age of 55, and have made an extraordinary national or international contribution to the game. Elected in four categories - Club Professional, Player, Teacher/Coach and Administrator- these individual's achievements must be in the form of dedication to his/her club; playing accomplishments on a national and world stage; promoting the game through teaching and player development or; exceptional contribution to the industry.

Each nomination must be seconded. Individuals may not nominate themselves; be a Director on the National Board; an employee of the PGA of Canada or; be a member of the PGA of Canada Hall of Fame Selection Committee.
